24/042	<p>Matters arising from the minutes of previous meetings</p> <p>It was reported that the recently installed SID in Affpuddle had been vandalised and the battery removed. This is believed to have occurred overnight Thursday 4th July night time. This will be reported to the Police. Initial queries for re-instating the SID have highlighted the following :-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Replacement Padlocks £43.22 plus vat • Replacement Battery £40 plus vat • Removeable secure battery box £100 plus vat <p>A removeable secure battery box was proposed to lessen the risk of the battery being stolen again. There is no charge for labour. Councillors agreed that this is needed to be resolved urgently and the clerk should go ahead and arrange for the work to be done. An item will be added to the next agenda for an update and formal minuted approval.</p> <p>An update was provided on the 20mph plan. Joe Allen at Dorset Council has confirmed a request to add a 4th survey to include Bladen Valley at the cost of £200 plus vat and residents have confirmed they will fund this. The total cost is now £875 plus vat for all surveys or which the Parish Council is committed to £675 plus vat. Once the survey is complete, the draft application will be updated and submitted to Dorset Council for consideration.</p>
