Technical information about this website's accessibility

- On the Contact Form the field content "(required)" instruction is low in contrast. All three fields on the form are required to be filled and a plain message appears below the field "this field is required" if the form is not filled in properly. Additionally, when the submit button is used and a field is not filled a cursor appears in the field and the text "this field is required" appears. The message will not be sent until the field is filled in.
